P: Steadfast and saving God,

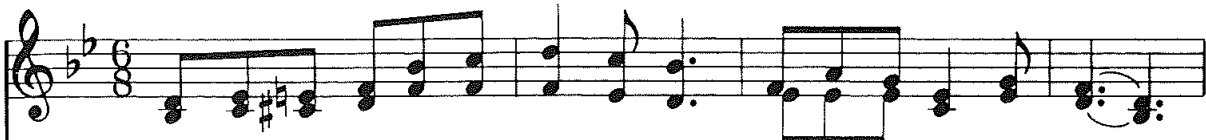
