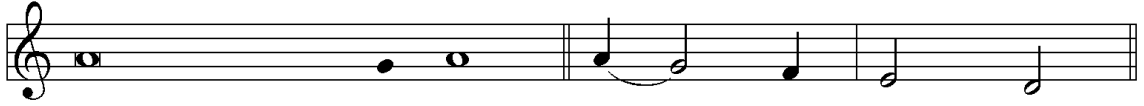

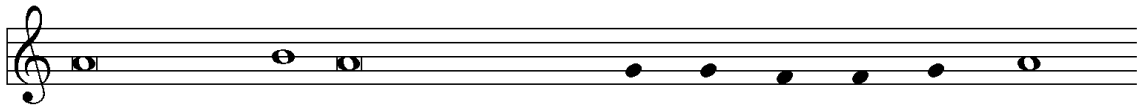

Churches United Silver Linings Apartments

Churches United has determined there is a great need for affordable sustainable housing for seniors aged 55+. Only three other affordable local housing projects support this segment of the population and they have zero capacity. To meet this dire need, Churches United is building Silver Linings Apartments in eastern Moorhead, adjacent to its Bright Sky Apartments. It will not only provide shelter but other vital services as well, such as a food pantry, 24-hour front desk support, health outreach, and onsite case management support.

Following years of communist oppression, Americans felt called to Martin, Slovakia to help spread the Gospel of a church-starved country. The result is a long-standing partnership between First Lutheran and the Center for Christian Education (CCE) in Martin, Slovakia. Ongoing financial help has enabled CCE *"to motivate people to know the truth so that they can become free in Christ to serve others..."* Currently CCE is seeking to incorporate more of the community as a way to further introduce families in Slovakia to its Christian ministry.
